PIANC USA ANNUAL MEETING RECORDING

On April 22 2021, PIANC USA hosted a virtual Annual Meeting for all members and those interested in learning more about PIANC USA. The meeting opened with remarks by Mr Vance Stewart III, the acting Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Civil Works). The key-note address was provided by Mr Francisco Esteban Lefler, President of PIANC. Mr Lefler addressed how PIANC has adapted in the COVID environment and plans for the organization moving forward. The US Principal Representatives to the PIANC Technical Commissions provided overviews of current and upcoming working groups and recently published reports. Dr Calvin Creech, PIANC-USA Liaison to PIANC America, provided an overview of the "PIANC Americas Initiative." This is a newly formed initiative that brings together leaders from North, Central, and South America in the areas of Port Infrastructure, Waterway Development and Waterborne Transport. There was a panel discussion consisting of four PIANC-USA leaders who discussed trends in future technologies related to ports, waterways, marinas, and coastal areas, as well as effects on the organization and the maritime community due to the COVID pandemic. The meeting concluded with recognition of PIANC-USA members who served on working groups that delivered published products and PIANC-USA leaders who completed their terms. UPDATES FROM PIANC USA YPCOM

DE PAEPE-WILLEMS AWARD- ABSTRACTS DUE AUGUST 31

This yearly prize is being given in honour of Professor Gustave Willems, President of PIANC from 1956 until his death in 1982. As the PIANC President for seventeen years, Robert De fostered Paepe international spirit and the professional development of PIANC. In 2002, it was decided



to merge the 'Foundation Robert De Paepe' with the Gustave Willems Award. Since 2003, the former Gustave Willems Award is known as the 'PIANC De Paepe-Willems Award'.

Contestants for the prize should not have reached the age of forty and they are required to submit a paper on subjects in the fields of design, construction, improvement, maintenance, or operation of inland and maritime waterways (rivers, estuaries, canals, port approaches), or inland and maritime ports and of coastal areas.

Three winning authors receive amounts of € 4,000.00, € 2,000.00, and € 1,000.00 respectively.

CALL FOR YOUNG PROFESSIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

WEDA

The Western Dredging Association is pleased to introduce the new WEDA Fellows program. Effective September 1, 2021, the program will provide an incentive for students to contribute to the advancement of the dredging profession through significant and sustained contribution to the dredging discipline via excellence in dredging education, innovation in practice or education, demonstrated meritorious service, and/or knowledge sharing.

The fellows program will provide \$5,000/term or \$10,000/school year to an eligible student. Eligible students are those currently in their senior year of undergraduate work and masters and doctorate students, a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0, and studies in educational disciplines including, but not limited to, dredging, coastal engineering, civil engineering (with a study focus on water), and oceanography.
