PIANC USA is currently seeking nominations for 3 upcoming vacancies on the National Commission for Commissioners Ed Schmeltz, Mike Leone, and Nick Pansic who are nearing the end of their 2nd term.

If you are interested or if you would like to nominate someone, please forward name, brief introduction, and CV resume to the PIANC USA Secretary at pianc@usace.army.mil BY NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 28TH. All nominations will be forwarded to the nominating committee.

While there are no specific prerequisites, it is recommended that nominees include one or more of the following considerations in his/her submission:

- Technical affinity to one or more of the PIANC Commissions (InCom, MarCom, RecCom, EnviCom, CoCom, YPCom) or the interests and goals of the U.S. Commission itself
- Regional location within the US to facilitate member outreach and region-specific technical conferences and programs
- Prior service as a US delegate to one of the PIANC Commissions and/or associated Working Groups
- Prior or current service to an US or International organization with a similar/common technical focus as PIANC

Unless otherwise indicated by the PIANC USA Chairperson, an individual appointed to the U.S. National Commission shall serve as a member for a term of four years. An appointed commissioner may be reappointed to a second term of four years. No person may serve more than two consecutive terms on the U.S. National Commission. No person in the active service of the United States Government shall be appointed without the prior approval of the head of the individual's government Department or Agency.
