## LEADERSHIP PROFILE

JAMES M. MARINO PIANC USA COMMISSIONER PRESIDENT, TAYLOR ENGINEERING INC.



From the time he was assigned to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Coastal Engineering Research Center (now CHL at ERDC) as a young Army Engineer officer, Mr. Marino began his journey with PIANC USA. The mentoring and coaching he received during this time from "legends" in the dredging, navigation, ports, and coastal industry was a major contributor to his decision to take on the role of PIANC USA Commissioner in 2015. Now armed with his own hard-won expertise in the field, he felt that it was his duty to give back and share his knowledge in his newfound leadership role.

LILLIAN ALMODÓVAR PIANC USA COMMISSIONER RETIRED, U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS



Upon joining PIANC USA, Ms. Almodóvar was looking to enrich her knowledge within the industry while providing valuable services that would last a lifetime. Previously serving as Deputy Director of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Institute for Water Resources, she was responsible for providing executive management support to relative institutions – such as PIANC USA. From this vantage point, she quickly realized the value that PIANC offered to its members, the global waterborne transportation sector, and to the industry at large. After that, she says, "my decision to join PIANC was an easy one."

One of the greatest aspects of Ms. Almodóvar's PIANC membership has been the knowledge she gained that helped her navigate challenges throughout her career. She credits this knowledge to international experts within PIANC, which have expanded her perspective on U.S. navigation. Working with so many international and industry leaders also helped her further broaden her network, develop her leadership skills, and expand her knowledge base of the field.

Early in her membership, Ms. Almodóvar provided direct support to the PIANC USA Latin America Liaison. She organized a session at the 2013 PIANC World Conference that invited delegates from Latin American countries to identify the needs and issues that are most critical to their respective countries. Her efforts around this session not only led to the development of an action plan for Latin America, but also to PIANC America, the ongoing effort spearheaded by PIANC USA to foster dialogue and sustainable growth in the Western Hemisphere. Ms. Almodóvar is thrilled to see this initiative continue to evolve, strengthen, and grow over time: The PIANC America 2023 Conference is the embodiment of a recommendation generated in the initial action plan, and will serve as a means to continue promoting the exchange of technical knowledge among nations in the Americas region.
