Dr. Creech first joined PIANC USA "to actively contribute to the advancement of waterborne transport infrastructure guidance," and doing

so has helped propel his career forward. Presenting his work at PIANC's global "prestigious events … have not only enhanced my visibility within the industry globally, but also facilitated valuable connections with colleagues, fostering continuous learning and professional growth." Eventually, Dr. Creech organized one of those prestigious events himself: the PIANC America 2023 Conference.

The PIANC America Conference provided a platform for industry experts to come together, exchange ideas, and discuss key challenges and opportunities in inland waterways, ports, recreational harbors, coastal resilience and environmental projects. LEADERSHIP PROFILE MATT MARTINEZ PIANC USA COMMISSIONER VICE PRESIDENT, MOFFATT & NICHOL



You may not find a better member-to-leader story than that of Matt Martinez. For years of his decades-long career in the marine engineering business, Matt referenced PIANC reports, attended PIANC events, and "had grown to recognize PIANC as the technically-based international authority on waterfront engineering." Mr. Martinez stepped into his current role as PIANC USA Commissioner both to expand the international basis of his practice, and to give back to PIANC – an organization from which he had been the beneficiary of so much technical expertise.

While leveraging the benefits of PIANC membership was the first step on his path toward becoming a Commissioner, presenting at PIANC conferences may have been the most critical one. Making technical presentations offered Mr. Martinez "exposure ... to a wider, international-oriented audience." And the more he interacted with PIANC, the more opportunities he saw for knowledge-sharing and career growth: as a leader in the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), "my duties routinely required me to interface with counterparts within PIANC U.S. These relationships gave me an expanded awareness that there was so much more to the engineering and construction world then what I can see from my San Diego, California horizon."

All of this culminated in Mr. Martinez's appointment as PIANC USA Commissioner in 2022. And when asked for highlights from his time with PIANC USA, Mr. Martinez did not hesitate to say: personal relationships.

"I have gotten to know a wide range of professionals that practice outside my specific area of expertise. These introductions cannot help but expand a person's thinking and understanding of all the various aspects of professional practice that must coalesce to accomplish the important work that we all undertake."

THE PIANC FRAMEWORK FOR IMPROVING WATERBORNE TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE

On 6 December 2023, serving in his role as PIANC Vice-President of the Americas, Dr. Calvin Creech had the privilege of presenting at the International Seminar of Brazilian Pilots in Brasilia, Brazil – promoting the value of PIANC together with newly established PIANC Brazil Section. The presentation was entitled "The PIANC Framework for Improving Waterborne Transport Infrastructure."

The event was hosted by the Praticagem do Brasil, a PIANC member and long-standing institution representing pilotage entities. Part of Praticagem do Brasil's 45th National Pilotage Meeting, the event focused on international instruments for responding to accidents involving large ships, such as the International Convention on Civil Liability for Damage Caused by Oil Pollution (CLC) and the International Convention on the Removal of Wrecks in Sea (Nairobi Convention).
